“We Walk Because They Walk”. What’s the point of walking?

There are 854 million people who go to bed hungry every night. Because of poverty they must walk to accomplish the most basic tasks: they walk for food, water, firewood, to escape violence, to seek shelter, to farm their fields, to find employment, to go to school. A CROP Hunger Walk is fun, but it is also an opportunity to learn what millions of people have to do each day just to survive—they walk. Let’s “put our best foot forward to end hunger and poverty.”

Where does the money go?

25% of the money raised goes to Operation Food Search and 75% goes to an organization which is chosen by the team or walker. **Team Temple Emanuel organizers strongly suggest that donators specify MAZON in the Alternate Agency Code towards the bottom of the online donor form.**

How to make a financial donation?*

Go to www.stlcropwalk.org, SEARCH Team TEMPLE EMANUEL and DONATE online. REMEMBER TO SPECIFY MAZON in the ALTERNATE AGENCY CODE towards the bottom of the online donor form.
